REGISTRATION

GALCAC reserves the right to accept or not accept registrations.

Registrations are not binding until payment has been made in full.

All registrations must be made with a full name and physical address.

Payment of Registration

The payment of the registration is either by credit card or bank deposit at the time of registration.

A registration is considered complete when full payment is received by the Conference Organiser.

The Australian goods and services tax (GST) at 10% is applicable to all goods and services offered by the Conference. All registration fees listed include GST.

Cancellation of Registration and Part Registration

Registrations can be cancelled and a full refund made up to 5 working days prior to the start of the conference.

Registrations cancelled within 5 working days will attract a \$100 administration fee, regardless of circumstances.

Registrations within 24 hours of the conference do not attract a refund.
