## Project Background

The Puntu Pirni Palya - Good Men project is visiting each Goldfields community and town 2 or 3 times a year. It is a mobile workshop in a truck. The workshop is for men to use to make artefacts, to gather, and yarn.

You are welcome to come along and visit the truck when you see it in your community.

Sit down to have a yarn or get your hands busy making an artefact!

## Why is the PPP truck coming to my community?

The truck is coming to provide men with a place to gather, share culture and language. A place for men to support men, and a place to yarn. Men's wellbeing is important for you, your family and your community!

The PPP truck is a place where Cultural Stewards can have access to equipment and resources to teach other men about artefacts.

## Community Cultural Stewards

In each community, a local Cultural Steward will be employed in the workshop to guide the space.

Let us know if there is someone in your community who would be great for this role. The Cultural Steward will help with artefact making and creating a safe space for men.

## The Artefacts Made

The artefacts you make will belong to you.

The wood and resources are provided free. You can make up to 3 types of artefacts each year. So 3 boomerangs, 3 spears, 3 sets of tapping sticks, 3 coolamons each year.

You can do what you like with your finished artefacts - keep them, give them away, sell them. They belong to you.
